WHAT ARE WE LEARNING?

In Math this term, we will be looking at counting to 50. We will also be looking at weight and understanding 'heavier' and 'lighter'. In our English learning we will be looking the Princess and the Frog. We will be focusing on setting descriptions, retelling and character descriptions. In Term 4, we will be learning about the Great Fire of London in History. In Geography we will be looking at cities in the UK. Children will continue to use the Little Wandle reading scheme, their reading book will go home on a Friday. Little Wandle books are a teaching resource that need to be returned on Monday morning.
